10	Plaintiff LHF Productions, Inc. moved the Clerk of Court on June 22, 2017, to enter default	
11	against defendants Derrick Boughton, Jose Gallego, Tom Gyarfas, Daniell Templeton, Kristina	
12	Walsh, and John Werber. ECF No. 49. But default was already entered against these defendants on	
13	May 8, 2017, in response to an earlier-filed motion. ECF Nos. 39 (motion), 41 (clerk's entry of	
14	default). Immediately after filing this June 22, 2017, motion, LHF filed a "Notice of Corrected	
15	Image" [ECF No. 50] noting that the earlier-filed motion was filed "in error and should be	
16	disregarded." The court suspects that the intent of this notice [ECF No. 50] was to withdraw the	
17	newly filed motion [ECF No. 49], but the notice mistakenly references the earlier-filed and already-	
18	granted one. Regardless, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for default [ECF No.	
19	<b>49] is DENIED.</b> Plaintiff is advised that, in the future, the proper vehicle for asking the court to	
20	disregard an erroneously filed motion is a notice of withdrawal.
