13	I. DISCUSSION	
14	Based on this Court's records, it appears that Plaintiff is no longer at the address listed	
15	with the Court. The postal service returned this Court's last mailing to Plaintiff as	
16	undeliverable. (See ECF No. 12). The Court notes that pursuant to Nevada Local Special	
17	Rule 2-2, "[t]he plaintiff must immediately file with the court written notification of any change	
18	of address. The notification must include proof of service on each opposing party or the party's	
19	attorney. Failure to comply with this rule may result in dismissal of the action with prejudice.'	
20	Nev. Loc. Special R. 2-2. This Court grants Plaintiff thirty (30) days from the date of entry of	
21	this order to file his updated address with this Court. If Plaintiff does not update the Court with	
22	his current address within thirty (30) days from the date of entry of this order, the Court wil	
23	dismiss this action without prejudice.	
24	Additionally, the Court denies the application to proceed in forma pauperis for prisoners	
25	(ECF No. 10) as moot because Plaintiff is no longer incarcerated. The Court now directs	

Plaintiff to file an application to proceed in forma pauperis by a non-prisoner within thirty (30)

days from the date of this order or pay the full filing fee of \$400.

II. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file his updated address with the Court no later than **June 2, 2017**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's application to proceed *in forma pauperis* for prisoners (ECF No. 10) is DENIED as moot.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court SHALL SEND Plaintiff the approved form application to proceed *in forma pauperis* by a non-prisoner, as well as the document entitled information and instructions for filing an *in forma pauperis* application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, no later than **June 2, 2017**, Plaintiff shall either: (1) file a fully complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis* for non-prisoners; or (2) pay the full filing fee of \$400.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if Plaintiff fails to timely comply with this order, the Court shall dismiss this case without prejudice.
