**ORDER ON REPORT AND
RECOMMENDATION**

(DKT. No. 3)

10 On January 5, 2017, Magistrate Judge Hoffman entered a report and recommendation that
11 I dismiss the plaintiff's complaint without prejudice because the plaintiff appears to have
12 abandoned the case. ECF No. 3. Plaintiff Iman Hakimi did not file an objection. Thus, I am not
13 obligated to conduct a de novo review of the report and recommendation. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)
14 (requiring district courts to "make a de novo determination of those portions of the report or
15 specified proposed findings to which objection is made"); *United States v. Reyna-Tapia*, 328 F.3d
16 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003) (en banc) ("the district judge must review the magistrate judge's
17 findings and recommendations de novo *if objection is made*, but not otherwise" (emphasis in
18 original)).

19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Judge Hoffman's report and recommendation (**ECF**
20 **No. 3**) is accepted. The plaintiff's complaint is dismissed without prejudice. The clerk of court
21 is instructed to close this case.
