Order Adopting Report and Recommendation, Granting and Denying Motions, and Dismissing Case

[ECF Nos. 21, 22, 27]

Gail Albanese appeals from the Commissioner's final decision denying Albanese disability insurance benefits. Albanese moved for reversal by summary judgment,<sup>1</sup> and the Commissioner cross-moved to affirm.<sup>2</sup> Magistrate Judge Cam Ferenbach recommends that Albanese's motion be granted, the Commissioner's cross-motion be denied, and this case be remanded to the administrative law judge for further proceedings.<sup>3</sup>

The report and recommendation was entered June 12, 2017, making June 26, 2017, the deadline to file an objection. No party has filed an objection to the report and recommendation. "[N]o review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed."<sup>4</sup>

Accordingly, with good cause appearing and no reason to delay, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Magistrate Judge Ferenbach's report and recommendation [ECF No. 27] is ACCEPTED and ADOPTED; Albanese's motion for summary judgment [ECF No. 21] is GRANTED; the
