ORDER

15 Petitioner, a citizen of India who is subject to an order of removal from the United States,
16 asks the court to issue a stay of the removal order. This court lacks jurisdiction to consider his
17 claim. 8 U.S.C. § 1252.

19 the court's conclusion to be debatable or wrong, and the court will not issue a certificate of
20 appealability.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this action is **DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certificate of appealability is **DENIED**.
