ORDER

Presently before the court is Plaintiff Karin H. Klein’s motion to reopen case (ECF No. 25), filed on November 21, 2017. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court’s order (ECF No. 21) granting the motion to remand is VACATED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk’s judgment (ECF No. 22) is VACATED.
