Order Adopting Report & Recommendation, Directing the Entry of Final Judgment, and Closing Case

In a 22-page report and recommendation evaluating whether sanctions are warranted against sole-remaining Defendant Bingli Yang and her counsel, Aaron Aquino, Esq., for continued violations of the court's orders, Magistrate Judge Nancy J. Koppe recommends that I enter default judgment against Yang for \$81,319 in compensatory damages, \$162,638 in punitive damages, and \$2,564 in attorney's fees. 1 The deadline to object to that report and recommendation was April 25, 2019, and no party has filed an objection or moved to extend the deadline to do so. "[N]o review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed."²

Accordingly, with good cause appearing and no reason to delay, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Report and Recommendation [ECF No. 85] is ADOPTED in full;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Clerk of Court is directed to ENTER FINAL JUDGMENT against Defendant Bingli L. Yang in the amount of
