**JOINT STIPULATION AND ORDER
FOR STAY OF THE PROCEEDINGS**

20 The Parties, by and through their respective counsel of record, hereby stipulate to stay the
21 proceedings in this case, in which Petitioner requests the Court to conduct a hearing *de novo*
22 under 8 U.S.C. § 1421(c) to determine Petitioner’s eligibility to naturalize.

23 Good cause exists to grant this stay. The Parties have agreed that U.S. Citizenship and
24 Immigration Services will re-open Petitioner’s N-400, Application for Naturalization, to conduct
25 a further examination on his application for naturalization pursuant to 8 C.F.R. Part 335.

26 Respondent will enter a status report upon scheduling of the examination, upon
27 completion of the examination, and upon the subsequent decision on Petitioner’s application for
28 naturalization.
