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 23 Plaintiffs Tameres Las Vegas Properties, LLC, Plaza Hotel & Casino, LL, and T-UPR,
 24 LLC (collectively "Plaintiffs") and Defendant The Travelers Indemnity Company ("Travelers"),
 25 by and through their respective counsel of record, hereby stipulate and request as follows:

26 1. WHEREAS, this Court entered an Order dated November 3, 2017 (ECF Doc. No.
 27 35) regarding various discovery motions that were filed by both the Plaintiffs' and Defendant

1 (ECF Doc. Nos. 31-34) wherein, this Order required that the parties withdraw their respective
2 motions, meet and confer regarding discovery disputes and submit any renewed briefs regarding
3 truly unresolved issues no later than November 13, 2017;

4 2. WHEREAS, pursuant to this Court's Order, the parties have withdrawn their
5 respective motions and have engaged in meet and confer meetings as well as exchanged emails in
6 an effort to resolve the active discovery disputes between the parties;

7 3. WHEREAS, on November 13, 2017, the parties submitted a stipulation and Order
8 to requesting that the Court permit the parties to submit renewed briefs on truly unresolved
9 discovery issues no later than December 4, 2017 which was subsequently Ordered by this Court
10 (ECF Doc. No. 48);

11 4. WHEREAS, on December 1, 2017, the parties submitted a second stipulation and
12 Order to requesting that the Court permit the parties to submit renewed briefs on truly unresolved
13 discovery issues no later than December 18, 2017 which was subsequently Ordered by this
14 Court (ECF Doc. No. 50);

15 5. WHEREAS, on December 15, 2017, the parties submitted a third stipulation and
16 Order to requesting that the Court permit the parties to submit renewed briefs on truly unresolved
17 discovery issues no later than January 8, 2018 which was subsequently Ordered by this Court
18 (ECF Doc. No. 52);

19 6. WHEREAS, the parties are still in the process of exchanging and reviewing the
20 supplemental discovery responses and document productions in order to continue to narrow and
21 resolve the discovery disputes between the parties;

22 7. WHEREAS, the parties' require additional time to review supplemental discovery
23 and potentially require additional meet and confer meetings prior to filing any renewed discovery
24 motions;
