
**Order Granting Motion to Extend Time**

[ECF No. 13]

In my April 21, 2017, order accepting and adopting Magistrate Judge Nancy J. Koppe’s recommendation that default judgment be entered against defendant Operture, Inc. for its failure to retain counsel, I instructed plaintiff U.S. Bank to file “a proposed order and judgment accompanied by a supplemental memorandum of points and authorities” within 10 days.<sup>1</sup> U.S. Bank now moves to extend that deadline to May 15, 2017, owing to counsel’s previously planned, out-of-state commitment.

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that **U.S. Bank’s motion to extend time [ECF 13] is GRANTED**; the time for U.S. Bank to file the proposed order and judgment and supplemental briefing is **EXTENDED to May 15, 2017**.
