I have found Ground 4 of the petition unexhausted and the petition therefore mixed, containing both unexhausted and exhausted claims. Petitioner advises, through 16 counsel, that he wishes to abandon Ground 4 and proceed on his exhausted claims.¹ 18 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Ground 4 of the petition is hereby DISMISSED 19 WITHOUT PREJUDICE. 20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondents must file an answer to the remaining claims of the petition by August 2, 2019.
