11 On March 16, 2017, Magistrate Judge Koppe entered her Report and Recommendation  
12 recommending dismissal of this case due to the plaintiff's repeated failure to file an amended  
13 complaint. ECF No. 13. The plaintiff did not object to that Report and Recommendation. He did,  
14 however, file two additional documents in the record attempting to lay out the authorities for the  
15 claims he hopes to assert in this case. ECF Nos. 14, 15. Those papers do not constitute an amended  
16 complaint, nor do they satisfy Magistrate Judge Koppe's requirements in her various orders in this  
17 case. Despite the absence of a formal objection to Magistrate Judge Koppe's Report and  
18 Recommendation, out of an abundance of caution I have conducted a de novo review of the issues  
19 set forth therein. Magistrate Judge Koppe's Report and Recommendation sets forth the proper legal  
20 analysis, and the factual basis, for the decision.

21 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Report and Recommendation (**ECF No. 13**) is  
22 **accepted, and this case is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.** The clerk of the court is  
23 directed to close this file.
