ECF No. 17. Pettigrew did not file an objection. Thus, I am not obligated to conduct 12 a de novo review of the report and recommendation. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (requiring district 13 14 courts to "make a de novo determination of those portions of the report or specified proposed 15 findings to which objection is made"); United States v. Reyna-Tapia, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003) (en banc) ("the district judge must review the magistrate judge's findings and 16 17 recommendations de novo if objection is made, but not otherwise" (emphasis in original)). 18 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Judge Koppe's report and recommendation (ECF 19 No. 17) is accepted. 20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff Donnelle Pettigrew's third amended complaint 21 is DISMISSED without prejudice.
