10	On September 26, 2017, Magistrate Judge Leen entered a report and recommendation that	
11	I deny plaintiff Imhotep Salat's request to proceed in forma pauperis and that I dismiss his	
12	complaint. ECF No. 3. Salat did not file an objection. Thus, I am not obligated to conduct a de	
13	novo review of the report and recommendation. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (requiring district courts to	
14	"make a de novo determination of those portions of the report or specified proposed findings to	
15	which objection is made"); United States v. Reyna-Tapia, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003)	
16	(en banc) ("the district judge must review the magistrate judge's findings and recommendations	
17	de novo if objection is made, but not otherwise" (emphasis in original)). I nevertheless conducted	
18	a de novo review. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Judge Leen sets forth the proper legal analysis and	
19	factual basis for the decision.	
20	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Judge Leen's report and recommendation (ECF No.	
21	3) is accepted. Plaintiff Imhotep Salat's application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF	
22	No.1) is DENIED.	
23	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the complaint is DISMISSED without prejudice to	
24	Salat pursuing his claims in state court. The clerk of court is instructed to close this case.
