11	On January 26, 2017, Magistrate Judge Nancy Koppe ordered plaintiff Mark Thomas, who is		
12	attempting to proceed in forma pauperis, to show cause why this case should not be dismissed under		
13	28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2), which requires dismissal if the court determines at any time that "the		
14	allegation of poverty is untrue." <sup>1</sup> Thomas filed no response, so the magistrate judge concludes that		
15	Thomas's allegation of poverty is untrue because the application in this case provides financial		
16	information radically different than what he provided in another case only a few months ago and is		
17	also internally inconsistent. She recommends dismissal with prejudice. "[N]o review is required of		
18	a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed." <sup>2</sup> Objections to the		
19	magistrate judge's report and recommendation were due by February 27, 2017, and no objections		
20	have been filed. <sup>3</sup> Accordingly,		
21	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the magistrate judge's report and recommendation [ECF		
22	No. 7] is ADOPTED, plaintiff's application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> [ECF No. 4] is
