LV Real 14 Estate Strategic Investment Group LLC Series 5112 et al, case number 2:17-cv-00084-JCM-NJK. 15 On January 16, the parties filed a stipulation and proposed order to stay the case. (ECF 16 No. 58). The stipulation references a certified question of law that Judge Boulware sent to the 17 Nevada Supreme Court. Id. 18 The stipulation does not demonstrate good cause for granting a stay in this case. The court 19 notes that the Nevada Supreme Court accepted the certified question on June 13, 2017, and briefing 20 on the issue has completed. However, the stipulation does not adequately demonstrate that a ruling 21 on the certified question will impact this litigation. 22 Accordingly, 23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties' stipulation to stay proceedings (ECF No. 60), 24 be, and the same hereby is, DENIED. 25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall have twenty-one (21) days to respond 26 to the outstanding motions for summary judgment. If any party responds, the moving party will 27
