The court notes, also, that the petition suggests that Bailey has not yet completed his state-court habeas litigation. See Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1-1), p. 1. If and when Bailey intends to initiate a habeas corpus action in this court, he must do so in a new action; to do so, Bailey must submit a petition for writ of habeas corpus on the correct form for use by a pro se prisoner petitioner, and either pay the \$5 filing fee, or, if unable to do so, file a new application to proceed in forma pauperis. Bailey must sign the documents he submits for filing. **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that petitioner's Application to *Proceed in Forma Pauperis* (ECF No. 1) is **DENIED**. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner's Ex Parte Motion for Appointment of Counsel (ECF No. 2) is **DENIED**. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this action is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner is denied a certificate of appealability. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall enter judgment accordingly.
