ORDER

- a. On or before **September 7, 2017**, Plaintiff must provide certification that he has completed the CM/ECF tutorial and is familiar with Electronic Filing Procedures, Best Practices, and the Civil & Criminal Events Menu that are accessible on this court’s website, www.nvd.uscourts.gov.
- b. Plaintiff is not authorized to file electronically until said certification is filed with the Court within the time frame specified.

2 at (702) 464-5555 to set up a CM/ECF account.
