29 On or about February 27, 2018 Defendants Continental Incorporated, Inc. d/b/a Continental  
 30 Enterprises (“Continental”) and Leapers, Inc. (“Leapers”) (collectively the “Defendants filed a Motion  
 31 for Award of Mandatory Attorney’s Fees, Costs, and Statutory Damages Pursuant to Nev. Rev. Stat.  
 32 §41.670 (Anti-SLAPP) (EFC Doc No. 60). By stipulation, the parties extended the Plaintiff’s deadline
