16       In this capital habeas corpus action, the petitioner, Marlo Thomas, filed a motion for stay on  
17 October 26, 2017 (ECF No. 27). Respondents filed an opposition to that motion on January 9, 2018  
18 (ECF No. 35). Thomas was due to file a reply to respondents' opposition to the motion on  
19 January 16, 2018. *See* LR 7-2(d) (7 days for reply).

20       On January 16, 2018, Thomas filed a motion for extension of time (ECF No. 37), requesting  
21 a 21-day extension of time -- to February 6, 2018 -- for his reply in support of his motion for stay.  
22 This would be the first extension of this deadline. Petitioner's counsel states that the extension of  
23 time is necessary because of her obligations in another case, and because of a period of mandatory  
24 administrative leave. Respondents do not oppose the motion for extension of time. The Court finds  
25 that the motion for extension of time is made in good faith and not solely for the purpose of delay,  
26 and that there is good cause for the extension of time requested.
