## ORDER

Here, Plaintiff must effectuate service on Defendant Rodriguez by May 15, 2017. (ECF No. 1). Plaintiff states that an additional 60 days is required to effect service. (ECF No. 21). As plaintiff has demonstrated “good cause” for its failure to effectuate service and provided support for its request for an

1 extension, the court will extend the 4(m) deadline for 60 days or until August 6, 2017. See Fed. R. Civ.  
2 P. 4(m).

3 Under 7-2(d), the failure of an opposing party to file points and authorities in response to any  
4 motion, except a motion under Fed. R. Civ. P. 56 or a motion for attorney's fees, constitutes a consent to  
5 the granting of the motion. No opposition has been filed. Here, it would seem that Defendants Jose  
6 Refugio Sandoval, Yvonne Gutierrez, and Atrium Gardens Home Owners Association have consented to  
7 the granted of the instant motion.

8 Accordingly, and for good cause shown,

9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Motion for Extension of Time to Serve Defendant Armando  
10 Rodriguez with Summons and Complaint (ECF No. 21) is GRANTED.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline to effect service of process will be extended for 60  
12 days, up to and including August 6, 2017.
