**REPORT AND  
RECOMMENDATION**

Plaintiff's Complaint (ECF No. 12) was filed on March 23, 2017. Therefore, the time limit for service on Defendant was June 21, 2017. On July 12, 2017, the Court filed a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Pursuant to Rule 4(m) for Plaintiff's failure to provide proof of service on Defendant. See ECF No. 18. The Court gave Plaintiff until August 11, 2017 to file a proof of service and demonstrate that Defendant was served prior to the expiration of the 90-day time limit set forth in Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m). *Id.* Plaintiff was cautioned that failure to comply with the Court's notice could result in a dismissal of the action. *Id.* Rather than file a proof of service, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Extend Time for Service three weeks after the August 11, 2017 deadline. See ECF No. 19. The Court denied Plaintiff's motion, without prejudice, on September 7, 2017 because Plaintiff did not adequately demonstrate whether good cause existed to grant the requested extension. *Order* (ECF No. 20). To date, Plaintiff has not filed a renewed motion for extension of time or filed a proof of service with the Court. Therefore, it appears that Plaintiff has abandoned this lawsuit.
