

As a result, plaintiff believes that a 30-day extension is more appropriate. <i>Id.</i> The court grants defendants' motion in full and extends the dispositive motion deadline by 90 days for both parties' benefit. If plaintiff cannot access the law library and is on 23-hour-a-day lockdown, he will be unable to prepare a response to any dispositive motions defendants may file. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that defendants' motion to extend time (ECF No. 49) be, and the same hereby is, GRANTED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file dispositive motions on or before Monday, September 7, 2020. DATED June 5, 2020.
