

10 In February 2020, after this case sat without any proceeding of record for more than two  
11 years and plaintiff was warned that his continued inaction would result in the case's dismissal,<sup>1</sup>  
12 this court dismissed this case for want of prosecution.<sup>2</sup> Six months later, plaintiff filed a request  
13 for reconsideration<sup>3</sup> and a "Respectful Request for Entry of genuine 1st party objective true-  
14 authentic: Fed. R. Ev. R-901(b)(1), Video-Audio April 28 2020 Sahara & Patosi DVD Evidence  
15 in support to This 'NOTICE.'"<sup>4</sup> Having carefully reviewed both submissions, the court finds no  
16 legitimate legal basis to set aside the dismissal and reopen this case or for any other form of  
17 relief in this closed case.

18 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motions [ECF Nos. 22, 23] are  
19 DENIED. This case remains closed and no additional filings may be made in this closed case.
