10	John Sabatini is an employee of Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department ("Metro")	
11	who works at the Clark County Detention Center and sues Metro under 42 U.S.C. § 1983,	
12	alleging that Metro violated his rights to freedom of expression and due process under state and	
13	federal laws when it fired Sabatini for certain posts that he made to his personal Facebook	
14	account. <sup>1</sup> Sabatini also alleges that Metro violated state and federal laws when it retaliated	
15	against him—by threatening to pull him from his current post assignment—for filing this action. <sup>2</sup>	
16	Sabatini now moves for an order temporarily restraining Metro from taking any adverse	
17	employment action against him. <sup>3</sup> The court believes that it will be beneficial to have a truncated	
18	briefing schedule and verbal argument by the parties on the issues raised by Sabatini's motion.	
19	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Metro has until June 2, 2017, to respond	
20	to Sabatini's motion for temporary restraining order [ECF No. 7]. Sabatini must file any reply	
21	by 3 p.m. on June 6, 2017. Sabatini's motion for temporary restraining order [ECF No. 7] will	
22	be heard at 9 a.m. on June 7, 2017, in Courtroom 6D of the Lloyd D. George U.S. Courthouse.
