



1 100, Las Vegas, NV 89146, with no success. Further, Plaintiff attempted to serve Defendant at a  
2 California address thought to be under his name, but the individual living at the address was not the  
3 Defendant. *See* ECF No. 5-5. The Court, therefore, finds that Plaintiff has provided sufficient  
4 good cause to warrant a 90 day extension of time to serve and service by publication. Accordingly,

5 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Motion to Extend Time to Serve (ECF No.  
6 5) is **granted**. Plaintiff shall have until **October 19, 2017** to effectuate service on Defendant  
7 Michael D. Mazur.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff's request to serve Defendant by publication is  
9 **granted** as follows:

- 10 1. Defendant Mazur may be served through publication of the summons and cross-  
11 claim in this case at least once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper  
12 of general circulation.
