10 On August 28, 2017, I ordered pro se petitioner Kelvin Wilson to show cause why this 28  
11 U.S.C. § 2254 habeas corpus petition shouldn't be dismissed as untimely.<sup>1</sup> I also warned him  
12 that failure to respond to my order within 30 days would result in the dismissal of this case. That  
13 30-day deadline has now passed, and Wilson has not responded to my order.

14 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Wilson's petition [ECF No. 6] is  
15 **DISMISSED with prejudice as time-barred.** I decline to issue a certificate of appealability  
16 because reasonable jurists could not find the forewarned dismissal of this case as time-barred to  
17 be debatable or wrong.

18 The **Clerk of Court** is directed to **enter judgment accordingly and CLOSE THIS**  
19 **CASE.**
