The parties propose staying all discovery in this case until 15 decision on defendant Hartford's Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 5). The motion to dismiss argues 16 The Hartford Financial Services Group, Inc. is not the insurer of the policy at issue in the complaint 17 and therefore is not a proper party defendant. The motion claims that the policy at issue, which 18 was attached to plaintiff's complaint, was issued by Sentinel Insurance Co., Ltd. Both defendants 19 are represented by the same counsel and no reason is given for why discovery should not proceed 20 with respect to defendant Sentinel. Accordingly, 21 IT IS ORDERED that the parties' Stipulation and Order to Stay Discovery Pending Ruling 22 on Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 14) is **DENIED**. The parties shall have until **July 11, 2017**, to 23 submit a proposed discovery plan and scheduling order. 24
