1	The Court in its Order [ECF No. 56] ordered that a joint pre-trial order be filed in this
2	case no later than October 20, 2023. The parties' counsel have met and conferred and have
3	agreed, subject to this Court's approval, that the October 20, 2023 deadline be extended for sixty
4	(60) days until December 19, 2023. This is the first request for an extension of time to file the
5	joint pre-trial order.
6	
7	D. <u>GOOD CAUSE EXISTS TO GRANT THE EXTENSION</u>
8	All discovery has been completed by the parties and dispositive motions have been ruled
9	upon by the Court. This extension is not sought for any improper purpose or other purpose of
10	delay. Rather it is sought by the parties solely to fully set forth the complexities of this case.
11	Counsel for Plaintiff has been preparing for criminal trials in State court and currently has
12	jury trials set for the months of November, December, January (2023) and February (2024).
13	
14	Counsel for Plaintiff is a solo practitioner. Counsel for Defendants likewise has had an intense
15	schedule regarding depositions and motion practice. Additionally, counsel for Defendants just
16	received notice that the Defendants will not be appealing this Court's Order [ECF No. 56]
17	denying the Defendant Officers Qualified Immunity.
18	Last, counsel for Defendants will be out of the jurisdiction for two weeks in November
19	2023 and has had to do other work in advance so he can leave the jurisdiction. The parties
