Having thoughtfully considered Klug's motion to remand and the Commissioner's cross-motion to affirm in a 31-page report and recommendation, Magistrate Judge Elayna J. Youchah 13 recommends that I deny Klug's motion to remand and grant the Commissioner's cross-motion.<sup>1</sup> The deadline for objections to that recommendation was yesterday, and no party has filed an objection to it or moved to extend the deadline to do so. "[N]o review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed."<sup>2</sup> IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the magistrate judge's report and recommendation 18 [ECF No. 27] is ADOPTED in full; IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT plaintiff's motion for reversal or remand [ECF No. 20 17] is DENIED and the Commissioner's cross-motion to affirm [ECF No. 20] is GRANTED. 22 <sup>1</sup> ECF No. 27.
