On January 7, 2019, the court gave Albanese until February 8, 2019, to seek leave of the Chief Judge of this Court to proceed.¹ Albanese was warned that if she failed to seek such 12 leave, this case would be dismissed with prejudice. Because Albanese did not seek such leave, 13 Magistrate Judge Ferenbach recommends that I dismiss this case with prejudice.² The deadline 14 for Albanese to object to that recommendation passed without any objection or other filing by 15 Albanese. "[N]o review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless 16 objections are filed." Having reviewed the report and recommendation, I find good cause to 17 18 adopt it, and I do. 19 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation [ECF No. 5] is ADOPTED in its entirety. 20 21 22 23 24 ¹ ECF No. 4. 25 ² ECF No. 19. 26 ³ Schmidt v.
