Costandi's ("Plaintiff") Motion for Reversal or to 15 Remand (ECF No. 20) and granting the Commissioner's Response and Cross-Motion to Affirm (ECF No. 21). The time to object has expired, the parties have filed no objections, and the parties 16 have consented to the undersigned proceeding with this matter. (ECF No. 26). 17 The court accepts and adopts the report and recommendation. The Court therefore finds 18 19 that the ALJ properly gave "clear and convincing" reasons supported by substantial evidence for affording less weight to the opinion of consultative examiner Dr. Cabaluna. The ALJ's decision 20 is supported by substantial evidence and free from reversible legal error.
