In addition, Mr. Salvador is hereby **ORDERED** to contact by telephone attorney Vantana Lay at 702-634-5000, no later than October 2, 2017, to coordinate a time and date for a Rule 26(f) conference. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions.

¹ If any of that contact information changes, a notice must be filed and served with the new contact information. *See* Local Rule IA 3-1. Failure to comply may result in case-dispositive sanctions. *See id.*
