In this habeas corpus action, Petitioner Omar Ayala, represented by appointed counsel, file a fourth amended habeas petition on May 13, 2021 (ECF No. 46). The respondents were then due on August 11, 2021, to respond to Ayala's fourth amended petition. <u>See</u> Order entered April 13, 2021 (ECF No. 45) (90 days for response).

On August 4, 2021, Respondents filed a motion for extension of time (ECF No. 48), requesting a 30-day extension, to September 10, 2021, to respond to Ayala's fourth amended petition. Respondents' counsel states that the extension of time is necessary because of his obligations in other cases. Petitioner does not oppose the motion for extension of time. The Court finds that Respondents' motion for extension of time is made in good faith and not solely for the purpose of delay, and there is good cause for the extension of time requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondents' Motion for Extension of Time (ECF No. 48) is **GRANTED**. Respondents will have until and including September 10, 2021, to respond to the fourth amended petition for writ of habeas corpus.

2	proceedings set forth in the order entered April 13, 2021 (ECF No. 45) will remain in effect.
