ORDER

(Mot WD Atty – ECF No. 24)

12 This matter is before the court on attorney Brandon C. Fernald of Fernald Law Group, LLP,  
13 and Lori Feldman of Geragos & Geragos APC's Motion to Withdraw as Counsel of Record for  
14 the plaintiff (ECF No. 24) filed March 29, 2018. Defendant filed a Non-Opposition (ECF No. 25)  
15 to the motion March 30, 2018. The motion represents that counsel have raised several concerns  
16 with plaintiff, including her obligation to comply with counsel's Legal Fee and Representation  
17 Agreement, and that those concerns have not been resolved. Mr. Fernald and Ms. Feldman have  
18 communicated with the client on multiple occasions, notified her of their intention to move to  
19 withdraw and served her with a copy of this motion. Additionally, counsel has provided the case  
20 file to Ms. Heller to enable her to find new counsel. They therefore seek leave to withdraw as  
21 counsel of record.

22 Having reviewed and considered the matter, and for good cause shown,

23 **IT IS ORDERED:**

24 1. The Motion to Withdraw (ECF No. 24) is **GRANTED**, and attorneys Brandon  
25 Fernald of Fernald Law Group, LLP, and Lori Feldman of Geragos & Geragos APC  
26 shall be removed as counsel for plaintiff.

27 2. The plaintiff shall have until **May 4, 2018**, in which to retain substitute counsel  
28 who shall make an appearance in accordance with the requirements of the Local

1 Rules of Practice, or shall file a notice with the court that she will be appearing in  
2 this matter *pro se*, that is, representing herself.

3 3. Plaintiff's failure to timely comply with this order by either obtaining substitute  
4 counsel, or filing a notice that she will be appearing in this matter *pro se* may result  
5 in the imposition of sanctions, which may include a recommendation to the District  
6 Judge that plaintiff's complaint be dismissed for failure to prosecute. See Fed. R.  
7 Civ. P. 41(b).
