Petitioner Kim Blandino has filed a pleading styled as an “Amended Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 2254 By a Person in State Custody.” ECF No.11. On October 12, 2017, I entered an order dismissing Blandino’s habeas petition for lack of jurisdiction. ECF No. 4. The court entered judgment the following day (ECF No. 5) and thereafter denied Blandino’s subsequent Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 59(e) motion (ECF No. 7). The United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit denied Blandino’s request for a certificate of appealability as to those decisions. ECF No. 10. Consequently, Blandino’s “amended petition” is an unauthorized pleading and shall be stricken from the record. *See* LR IA 10-1(d) (“The court may strike any document that does not conform to an applicable provision of these rules or any Federal Rule of Civil or Criminal Procedure.”).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall strike petitioner Kim Blandino’s “amended petition” (ECF No. 11) from the record.
