His 10 request for reconsideration was denied. After a de novo hearing, an administrative law judge 12 found that Oblitas suffered from multiple physical impairments but was not disabled during the relevant timeframe and denied him benefits.<sup>2</sup> Oblitas moves to reverse or remand this case to the Social Security Administration for further proceedings,<sup>3</sup> and the Commissioner cross moves to affirm the administrative law judge's decision.<sup>4</sup> 15 16 Magistrate Judge Cam Ferenbach reviewed the parties' motions and recommends that I grant Oblitas's motion to reverse or remand, deny the Commissioner's cross motion to affirm, and remand this case to the Social Security Administration for a calculation of benefits.<sup>5</sup> Judge Ferenbach issued his report and recommendation on July 17, 2018, making July 31, 2018, the deadline to file objections. review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed."6 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Magistrate Judge Ferenbach's report and recommendation [ECF No. 22] is ACCEPTED and ADOPTED. Oblitas's motion to reverse or 5 remand [ECF No. 17] is GRANTED, the Commissioner's cross motion to affirm [ECF No. 20] is DENIED, and this case is REMANDED to the Social Security Administration for a calculation of benefits.
