**Order Denying Motion to Vacate Order
and Judgment**

10 I previously dismissed this habeas corpus action because petitioner Frederick
11 Banks did not pay the filing fee or file a completed and proper application to
12 proceed *in forma pauperis*, and because his petition on behalf of “Jason Aldean,
13 country music star and 22,000 concert attendees at Mandalay Bay, [the] Estate of
14 Stephen Paddock, and Mary Lou Danely by and through Hamilton Brown, LLP” to
15 compel the disclosure of FISA electronic surveillance¹ was obviously meritless.² I
16 also denied Banks a certificate of appealability, and judgment was entered
17 accordingly.³ Banks filed a notice of appeal⁴ and now moves to vacate my previous
18 order and judgment.⁵ But he identifies no reason—and there is none—for me to
19 reconsider my order or to grant him relief from the judgment.
