12	This Court has an obligation to determine its jurisdiction to hear a particular case. The	
13	Court has reviewed the Complaint in this case and finds that the Complaint has not stated or	
14	provided a basis for this Court's jurisdiction in this case. The Complaint references trespass	
15	without establishing how this alleged trespass would establish federal jurisdiction.	
16	The Plaintiff has filed a Motion to Amend his Complaint [13]. The Court has reviewed	
17	this Motion and finds that the attached Amended Complaint also does not establish a basis for this	
18	Court's jurisdiction. The Court further finds that granting a further motion to amend the Complaint	
19	would be futile as Plaintiff has not set forth an intelligible basis for this Court to have jurisdiction.	
20	Indeed, in Plaintiff's filing for a Motion for Relief [14], a reference is made to a claim being filed	
21	and not a complaint as required by law.	
22	For the reasons stated above,	
23	IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED, and Plaintiff's Motion to Amend [13] is	
24	DENIED. All other pending motions or request for relief are DENIED as moot.
