Respondents indicate that they do not oppose the 17 Motion. (ECF No. 59). Good cause appearing, this action is reopened. 18 It is therefore ordered that Petitioner's Motion to Reopen Case (ECF No. 58) is GRANTED. 19 20 It is further ordered that Petitioner has 90 days from the date of this Order to 21 FILE AND SERVE on Respondents a Fourth-Amended Petition for Writ of Habeas 22 Corpus. 23

It is further ordered that Respondents file a response to the Fourth-Amended
Petition within **60 days** of service of the Petition, with any requests for relief by
Petitioner by motion otherwise being subject to the normal briefing schedule under the
Local Rules.

It is further ordered that Petitioner has **45 days** from service of the response to file a Reply or Opposition, with any other requests for relief by Respondents by motion otherwise being subject to the normal briefing schedule under the Local Rules.
