Order Granting Motions to Strike Unauthorized Amended Complaints

[ECF Nos. 47, 49]

Nearly a month after defendants filed a motion to dismiss,¹ pro se plaintiff Anthony 8 9 Ruben Aldo Barbieri filed first and second amended complaints without leave of court.² 10 Defendants move to strike those amended complaints as fugitive documents.³ Good cause 11 appearing, and because those amended complaints were filed more than 21 days after service of 12 defendants' motion to dismiss and without first obtaining the court's permission,⁴ IT IS 13 HEREBY ORDERED that the motions to strike the amended complaints [ECF No. 47, 49] are 14 GRANTED. Plaintiff's First and Second Amended Complaints [ECF Nos. 46, 48] are 15 HEREBY STRUCK.
