Stipulated TRO") against the Gomez Defendants; and (ii) vacating the evidentiary hearing on the
FTC's motion for a preliminary injunction as to the Gomez Defendants. The FTC and the
Gomez Defendants, each of which is represented by counsel for purposes of this stipulation,

HEREBY STIPULATE TO THE FOLLOWING:

The duration of the Gomez Stipulated TRO [ECF No. 57] is extended and shall

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remain in place by consent of the Gomez Defendants until the Court issues a ruling on the FTC's request for a preliminary injunction as to the Gomez Defendants, or further order of the Court. Unless otherwise ordered, all provisions of the Gomez Stipulated TRO shall remain in place during the extension, including the asset freeze and appointment of the receiver Robb Evans & Associates LLC. The Gomez Defendants specifically reserve all rights and nothing herein shall be construed as an admission of any kind or impair Gomez Defendants' right to assert any and all defenses they may have. The reason for the extension of the Gomez Stipulated TRO is to allow the FTC to review and, if appropriate, approve a stipulated final order for permanent injunction and monetary relief as to the Gomez Defendants ("Gomez Stipulated Final Order"). FTC counsel are submitting the Gomez Stipulated Final Order to the FTC for review and approval, and are informed that the approval process could take up to eight weeks. If the FTC approves the Gomez Stipulated Final Order, it will be filed for approval by the Court. If approved by the FTC and the Court, the Gomez Stipulated Final Order will resolve all disputes

between the FTC and the Gomez Defendants and obviate the need for a preliminary injunction
