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Presently before the court is plaintiff Mansell Roy Williams’ motion for extension of time to respond to defendant Smith’s Food and Drug Centers, Inc.’s (“Smith’s”) motion to dismiss (ECF No. 30). (ECF No. 34). Smith’s filed a response. (ECF No. 35).

Williams requests that the court extend the deadline to file a response to Smith’s motion to dismiss (ECF No. 30) to December 7, 2018. (ECF No. 34). Williams argues that there is good cause to extend the filing deadline in light of “counsel’s extraordinary work schedule, including a complex week-long trial . . . coupled with important family obligations.” Good cause appearing, the court will grant Williams’ motion.
