IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the parties, that the time for Plaintiff Universal Entertainment Corporation ("UEC") to file its Response to Defendants' Motion for Sanctions Against UEC and Fujimoto ("Motion for Sanction," filed under seal on March 26, 2021 – ECF No. 321) is extended for fourteen (14) days, from April 9, 2021 to April 23, 2021. The above extension requests are to provide counsel additional time to evaluate the voluminous allegations and exhibits associated with the Motion for Sanction and Motion to Seal, and to provide additional pages and time for their respective filings.
