| 14 | At ECF Nos. 237 and 242 are motions for sanctions and to compel, respectively. Since |
| 15 16 | March 22, 2021, those motions have been set for an April 30, 2021 hearing. ECF No. 243. The Court previously ordered that, as to ECF No. 242, defendant's response was due |
| 17 | April 2, 2021, and plaintiff's reply was due April 9, 2021. ECF No. 241. Instead, however, defendant's response to ECF No. 242 was filed on April 21, 2021. ECF No. 248. Further, he parties filed a stipulation at ECF No. 249 asking the Court to accept the belated |
| 18 | response nunc pro tunc and to extend the deadline for plaintiff's reply to 12:00 PM on |
| 19 | April 29, 2021 (i.e., 1 day before the hearing). |
| 20 | In an effort to ensure the presentation of this case on the merits, the Court will accept the |
| 21 | parties' stipulation. Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that ECF No. 249 is GRANTED. However, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the April 30, 2021 hearing is VACATED and |
