referred to as "Defendant Walmart"), by and through their attorneys of record, Robert K. Phillips and Timothy D. Kuhls of the law firm PHILLIPS, SPALLAS & ANGSTADT, LLC, submit this **STIPULATION AND ORDER TO CONTINUE TRIAL** for the Court's consideration.

Good cause exists for continuing the trial date. The parties have diligently prosecuted and defended this case, and have only requested short extensions of time previously. The first extension was a result of the parties' stipulation to continue trial on October 14, 2020 (ECF 43, 44). The second extension was a result of the parties' stipulation to continue trial on February 10, 2021 (ECF 52, 53).

The parties have been diligent in this matter, but unforeseen circumstances have made attending trial in December difficult. Additionally, Defendant's expert, Dr. McIntire is not available to testify the week of December 13th. Accordingly, judicial economy and efficiency favor a brief continuance of the trial in this matter. The parties have also been working together in an attempt to settle this matter. A continuance of trial will provide additional time for the parties to discuss settlement negotiations. Moreover, should those negotiations not be successful, a brief extension of time will provide the parties an opportunity to more fully prepare for trial in order to present thorough and well briefed claims and defenses. Furthermore, continuing trial may allow another unresolvable matter on the Court's lengthy trial stack to proceed to trial in a more timely manner. Lastly, in the event the parties are unable to resolve this matter, they will require some time to determine the availability and travel capabilities of various witnesses and experts that reside out of state.

Accordingly, the parties are requesting a continuation of the trial date. The current trial date is December 13, 2021, with the Calendar Call on November 23, 2021. The parties respectfully request that the trial in this matter be continued to this Court's February trial stack, or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard. This will allow the parties an adequate opportunity to further pursue resolution, as detailed above. The parties likewise request a continuance of all other deadlines associated with trial in
