

10 This matter is before the Court on the parties' Stipulation to Extend Discovery Dates
11 (ECF No. 11), filed on February 10, 2021. The Court has reviewed the stipulation and finds that
12 it does not comply with LR 26-3. "A motion or stipulation to extend a discovery deadline . . .
13 must include: (a) A statement specifying the discovery completed; (b) A specific description of
14 the discovery that remains to be completed; (c) The reasons why the deadline was not satisfied or
15 the remaining discovery was not completed within the time limits set by the discovery plan; and
16 (d) A proposed schedule for completing all remaining discovery." LR 26-3. Based on the
17 information provided in the stipulation, the Court is unable to evaluate the progress the parties
18 have made since their first stipulation to extend discovery. The Court will therefore deny the
19 stipulation without prejudice. The parties are directed to file a stipulation that complies with
20 Local Rule 26-3, with specific emphasis on describing the discovery completed to date and the
21 discovery that remains to be completed. *See* LR 26-3(a)-(d).

22 Accordingly,

23 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties' Stipulation Extending Discovery Dates
24 (ECF No. 11) is **denied without prejudice**.
