**ORDER**

14 Before the Court is the Motion for Plaintiffs to Have Access to View and File Motions  
15 Electronically (ECF No. 6). Plaintiffs request access to view all court records and permission to file  
16 electronically. The Court will allow Plaintiffs to file future documents electronically only after each  
17 Plaintiff demonstrates a basic understanding and familiarity with the Court's CM/ECF filing system.

18 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion for Plaintiffs to Have Access to  
19 View and File Motions Electronically (ECF No. 6) is GRANTED. Plaintiffs must comply with the  
20 following procedures in order to activate their respective individual CM/ECF account:

- 21 a. On or before December 18, 2020, each Plaintiff must provide certification that he  
22 has completed the CM/ECF tutorial and is familiar with Electronic Filing  
23 Procedures, Best Practices, and the Civil & Criminal Events Menu that are  
24 accessible on this Court's website at [www.nvd.uscourts.gov](http://www.nvd.uscourts.gov).
  - 25 b. Plaintiffs are not authorized to file electronically until the certification is filed  
26 with the Court within the time frame specified.

2 Desk at (702) 464-5555 to set up their individual CM/ECF account.
