9	I. DISCUSSION			
10	On November 16, 2020, Plaintiff, an inmate in the custody of the Clark County Detention			
11	Center ("CCDC"), submitted a civil rights complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. (ECF No. 1-1).			
12	Plaintiff has neither paid the full \$400 filing fee for this matter nor filed an application to proceed <i>in</i>			
13	forma pauperis.			
14	Under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2) and Local Rule LSR 1-2, an inmate seeking to commence a			
15	civil action may apply to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> , which allows the inmate to file the civil action			
16	without prepaying the full \$400 filing fee. To apply for <i>in forma pauperis</i> status, the inmate must			
17	submit <u>all three</u> of the following documents to the Court:			
18	(1) a completed Application to Proceed <i>i</i>	n Forma Pauperis for Inmate, on this Court's		
19	approved form (i.e. pages 1 through 3 with the inmate's two signatures on page 3),			
20	(2) a <u>Financial Certificate</u> properly signed by both the inmate and a prison or jail official			
21	(i.e. page 4 of this Court's approved form), and			
22	(3) a copy of the inmate's prison or jail trust fund account statement for the previous			
22	six-month period.			
23 24	The Court grants Plaintiff a <u>one-time</u> extension to file a fully complete application to proceed			
24 25	<i>in forma pauperis</i> containing <u>all three</u> of the required documents, or in the alternative, pay the full			
	\$400 filing fee for this action on or before January 19, 2021. Absent unusual circumstances, the			
26	Court will <u>not</u> grant any further extensions of time.

If Plaintiff is unable to file a fully complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis* with all three required documents or pay the full \$400 filing fee on or before **January 19, 2021**, this case will be subject to dismissal <u>without prejudice</u> for Plaintiff to file a new case with the Court when Plaintiff is either able to acquire all three of the documents needed to file a fully complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis* or pays the full \$400 filing fee.

A dismissal <u>without prejudice</u> means Plaintiff does not give up the right to refile the case with the Court, under a new case number, when Plaintiff has all three documents needed to submit with an application to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Alternatively, Plaintiff may choose not to file an application to proceed *in forma pauperis* and instead pay the full filing fee of \$400 on or before **January 19, 2021** to proceed with this case.

The Court will retain Plaintiff's civil rights complaint (ECF No. 1-1), but the Court will not file the complaint unless and until Plaintiff timely files a fully complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis* with all three documents or pays the full \$400 filing fee.

II. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall send
 Plaintiff the approved form application to proceed *in forma pauperis* by an inmate, as well as the
 document entitled information and instructions for filing an *in forma pauperis* application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before **January 19, 2021**, Plaintiff shall either pay the full \$400 filing fee for a civil action (which includes the \$350 filing fee and the \$50 administrative fee) or file with the Court:

(1) a completed <u>Application to Proceed *in Forma Pauperis* for Inmate</u> on this Court's approved form (i.e. pages 1 through 3 of the form with the inmate's two signatures on page 3),

(2) a <u>Financial Certificate</u> properly signed by both the inmate and a prison or jail official
(i.e. page 4 of this Court's approved form), and

25 (3) a copy of the <u>inmate's prison or jail trust fund account statement for the previous</u>
 26 <u>six-month period</u>.

1	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if Plaintiff does not file a fully complete application to
2	proceed in forma pauperis with all three documents or pay the full \$400 filing fee for a civil action
3	on or before January 19, 2021, this case will be subject to dismissal without prejudice for Plaintiff
4	to refile the case with the Court, under a new case number, when Plaintiff has all three documents
5	needed to file a complete application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> or pays the full \$400 filing fee.
6	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall retain the complaint (ECF
7	No.1-1) but will not file it at this time.
