Order Accepting Report and Recommendation

[ECF No. 3]

8 On December 17, 2020, Magistrate Judge Albregts recommended that I dismiss plaintiff
9 Thomas Curtis's complaint with prejudice because the complaint is frivolous. ECF No. 3. He
10 also recommends that I deny as moot Curtis's application to proceed in forma pauperis. *Id.*
11 Curtis did not object. Thus, I am not obligated to conduct a de novo review of the report and
12 recommendation. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (requiring district courts to "make a de novo
13 determination of those portions of the report or specified proposed findings to which objection is
14 made"); *United States v. Reyna-Tapia*, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003) (en banc) ("the
15 district judge must review the magistrate judge's findings and recommendations de novo if
16 *objection is made*, but not otherwise" (emphasis in original)).

17 I THEREFORE ORDER that Magistrate Judge Albregts' report and recommendation
18 (ECF No. 3) is accepted, plaintiff Thomas Curtis's complaint (ECF No. 1-1) is DISMISSED, and
19 his application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 1) is DENIED as moot. The clerk of
20 court is instructed to close this case.
